Walt Prest was unable to attend the January meeting, but sent in this report:

## COCKAIGNE TRIP REPORT

The trip is over and I believe it was a success in that everyone appeared to have an enjoyable time, it was an inexpensive trip for our respective club members, and each club gained at least one new member from the trip.

There were, to the best of my knowledge, 83 folks in attendance.

Paul Holabaugh had procured medals for games that he ran and I believe he has quite a few medals left over. He will bill the Shenango club for the medals and I offer the suggestion that some of these may be used in March for the Pk'nPk kids program that Michalene is running.

The Western PA Ski Council approved up to \$500.00 as a subsidy, since it was a three club event (actually any WPSC club could have attended). The bill from Cockaigne for the provided meal came to \$482.45 and I will send a check for that amount, to be reimbursed by the Council. The invoice is broken down as follows:

12 Pizzas @ \$18.95 =	\$227.40
169 Beverage tickets @ \$.80 =	\$135.20
3 Chips & Salsa (served 30 each) @ \$39.95 =	<u>\$119.85</u>
	<u>TOTAL = \$482.45</u>

All clubs billed their members for the \$20.00 lift ticket and paid that directly to Cockaigne. Shenango had also billed their members for rentals, lessons and beginner packages and paid those directly to Cockaigne. Unfortunately, I have no record of those numbers, but there were 49 total Shenango members present.

The Shenango and Erie clubs procured buses for their groups, with the Meadville club riding on the Erie bus. The Shenango club procured their own bus at a cost of \$800.00 and provided snacks to their members for the ride.

The Erie club also provided a bus for their 27 members and 7 Meadville members joined them. Their bus cost was \$775.00 and they also served coffee, donuts and juice to the riders. Assuming a total cost of about \$800.00, Meadville will reimburse the Erie club \$165.00 as their share of the bus cost. Dave DeGrange, Meadville Ski Club Treasurer, will send a check for that amount to: Erie Ski Club, P.O. Box 3434, Erie, PA 16508.

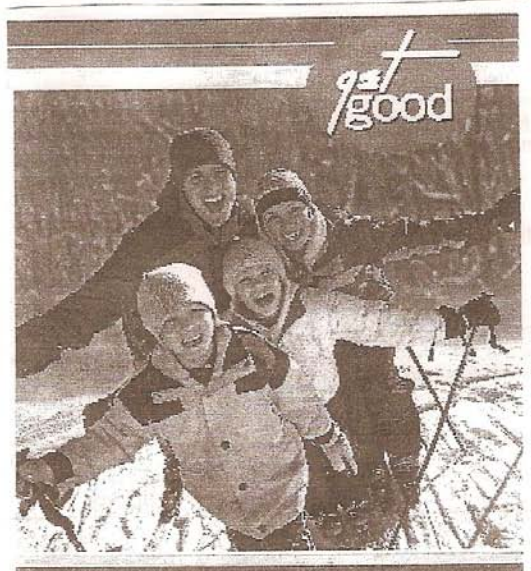
